After Attending A Full Gospel Business Men's Breakfast, I Was Baptized With The Holy Spirit In A Business Office, And My Life And The Life Of My Church People Testify As To What God Is Doing At Park Road Christian Church!

SO MANY THINGS have happened during the past few months, it is hard to know where to start this testimony, for God is blessing Park Road Christian Church in a mighty way!

It had its beginning last year when I was invited to attend a breakfast at the Davenport Hotel in Spokane, Washington, sponsored by the Spokane Chapter of Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International. James Brown, a Presbyterian minister of a church at Parkesburg, Pennsylvania, was the guest speaker. He told of his experience in the filling of the Holy Spirit. His testimony touched me very deeply. Had it come from a Pentecostal preacher, I would have expected it, but coming from a Presbyterian — that was another story!

Then again, during the month of September, Jack Robins, formerly Jacob Rabinowitz, gave his testimony. He had come from seventeen generations of Jewish Rabbis. He had been trained from his childhood to become a Rabbi. He was converted to Christianity in an Assembly of God Church

and later was filled by the Holy Spirit. He is now a teacher of one of the largest men's Bible classes in the Methodist Church. His story is extremely interesting. Both of these men had a profound influence upon me and although I didn't know it then, I was headed for a most blessed experience myself!

There had been a feeling of a lack of power in my ministry for a long time. I was never quite satisfied with my delivery. I was a slave to notes. I felt I wasn't getting the message of Christ across. I had always preached a positive Gospel and God had blessed the messages with conversions. Yet something was lacking. The attendance at Park Road was not too bad, but not gaining as it should. Interest was nominal. Folks came to church but seemed little interested in whether they worked at the job of Christianity or not. The harder I worked, the slower things seemed to move along. Only a few of our people were exerting any energy in the program. Because of the financial arrangement, I work nearly

full time I can't spend much time calling and, in fact, it isn't very often I get to sit down to meditate and study. I, along with the people of Park Road, was willing to let such a condition exist because "I had to work full time."

On a Tuesday of last December, while making some calls, I stopped at the establishment of a business friend, Byron Klaue, to congratulate him on his new building. Byron had installed a very nice executive office on the second floor. This office proved to be a very important place to me. In the course of conversation, Klaue mentioned that I could receive the filling of the Holy Spirit right then. He

stated that he had had a lock put on the door of his office for the purpose of privacy. I told him to lock the door!

I knew nothing of what would follow. My opinion of such things was lots of noise, agonizing — the sort of thing we have seen or heard about during Pentecostal meetings. He asked me to sit in a reclining chair. I had expected to get on my knees. Then he went around behind me and asked me to hold up my arms. He took hold of them to aid me when they tired. He began to pray, asking the Lord to fill me. He told me what to do. Finally, when I was ready to give up and admit such an experience was not for me, something took hold of my voice and

out tumbled a language I had never heard before! I did not know what I was saying: I had never before heard that language. I listened as I spoke trying to figure out what language I was speaking. I was not in a trance nor was I out of my mind. I could hear every word I was saying. How I wished I could understand what it was that came from my mouth. One thing I do know: I was praising the Lord in a language He understood! I saw millions of people before me. Perhaps I was speaking their language. This talking in tongues went on for about an hour.

The following day, with my entire being tingling, I had difficulty speak-

ing the English language fluently. It is not hard for me to speak. In fact, I talk too rapidly at times. However, that day I had to slow up greatly in order to be understood. I was actually afraid tongues would come out again. In making my sales presentation, I had to correct myself many times. God had certainly filled me. It is as easy now to praise God in an unknown tongue as it is in English.

On the following Sunday morning, I announced at the close of the service that I had a personal testimony to give that evening. Fifty-five people came to hear what I had to say. I was trembling from head to foot as the sermon began. A spirit of quietness fell over

the congregation that I have never felt in any Christian Church before! Generally, there is so much commotion and noise, one has to fight for attention and worship. When the invitation was given for those who would like a similar experience, three came forward: an elder and two young people. Before the night was over, the two young people had been filled by God and praised Him in a heavenly language. One of those was my son Ward, the other one of our teen-age girls.

I received my Bachelor of Theology degree from Northwest Christian College, Eugene, Oregon, in 1943. I then went to Oregon State College, Corvallis, Oregon, and completed my Bachelor of Science degree. During that time, I was Associate Pastor of the First Christian Church in Albany, Oregon. Later I returned to Oregon State College and did work on my Master's Degree in Family Life. I have been preaching eighteen years in the Christian Churches of Washington and Oregon. Every time my brother, Bernard Correll, Minister of the Assembly of God Church in South Sioux City, Nebraska, and I got together, we clashed over the teaching concerning the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. Yet the experience which previously I had said was not true, and was not for this age, happened to me. The Lord flooded my soul and I became a different person.

I feel a release and power I have not previously experienced. Whereas I would take a full set of notes into the pulpit and follow them closely, now I may have only a few scriptures on a piece of paper. My greatest burden now is to gently lead my congregation into a deeper experience with Christ. I try to visualize the Church blessed with the spiritual gifts listed in the

12th chapter of I Corinthians. What service it could render to such a needy world. What a power the church could become if it would only receive that which God has for it. Unbelief has kept the gifts back.

I am convinced of this: in the words of Dr. John H. Osteen, Pastor of the Lakewood Baptist Church, Houston, Texas, "Pentecost is not a Denomination: it is an experience." One of the great tragedies of the age is that Christianity as a whole has been very slow to accept it. Even today, there are those who question the Scripturality of the filling and its import. There have been many opinions and attitudes built up concerning it by reports or observation by those who did not understand what they heard or saw.

My experience was in no way fanatical. I laid on a reclining chair, my eyes were closed, and I relaxed in the presence of Christ. I am convinced this is the power the Church needs today to meet the challenges. With Communism on the march, delinquency mounting in every state of the Union, with materialism raising its ugly head even in the midst of the Church, there is need of a greater power in the Body of Christ. I am convinced the greatest power the Church can have today is spiritual power and that power comes through "the unity of the Spirit." (Ephesians 4:3). When the Church awakens to the spiritual power God has to bestow, then there will be a revival sweep over this land in a mighty wave. Programs, organizations or education alone will never do it. Remember the Lord said, "Not by might, nor by power, but by MY SPIRIT, saith the Lord of Hosts." (Zech. 4:6). Christians, heed the admonition of the Lord; seek Him; let

His Spirit fill you genuinely and "from within you shall flow rivers of living water" (John 7:38).

My testimony has not ended yet, for already the Lord has blessed in healing many souls. The Lord is pouring His spirit out upon Park Road Church. Along with those mentioned, eight more have been filled. No longer have the young people been alone in responding, for five adults now have come into this experience. I feel there is yet much to do in helping others of my people at Park Road to receive the filling of the Holy Spirit. There are multitudes of

others everywhere who will listen to the message and desire God's richest blessing. I am finding spiritually-starved people all around.

The Spirit of the Lord is sweeping over the land. Many ministers and lay people in a number of Communion are receiving this blessing. The hour is late, the coming of the Lord is fast approaching; the Church must be ready. May our wonderful God be patient with us who doubted so long, that we may join with the thousands of others in taking a message of power and blessing to a thirsty land!

Now in these last days God is moving quickly, and in a matter of a few minutes they are speaking in tongues as evidence of the infilling of the Holy Spirit according to Acts 2:4. For the Lord said, "And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh" — Acts 2:17.

As A Presbyterian, I Was Thrilled To Hear An Episcopal Priest Tell In A Full Gospel Business Men's Breakfast About The Holy Spirit. In A Business Office, I Received This Experience; Now I Know That The Holy Spirit Is As Real As On Day Of Pentecost!

HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED how many people carry an intellectual acceptance of the idea of God, believing they are Christians, but who have never experienced a changed life, or how many have experienced a changed life, but have never suspected that there might be for them another long step into the reality of God's love and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit? This question has recurred to me very often and very forcefully during the last few months.

There was a time during my high school years when I rejected any belief that I had had in God. Then, through the ministry of one of my teachers, I gradually came back, started going to Sunday school and church, and eventually became a member of the Presbyterian church in that small town. I know I was a "believer," but my "belief" had not changed my life.

A little over six years ago, after a lapse of eighteen years, the change came. It would be a long story to tell all the circumstances, so I will merely say that my husband and I and our two small sons were in difficult times, with illness, business problems, and worries of many kinds; and at the same time we were hearing some powerful sermons in the Presbyterian church of which we were members. One night I awakened from a dream in which Christ was standing a distance away, beckoning and saying, "Follow Me." I followed,

and when I awakened, I was crying and saying over and over again, "I want to give my life to God." It was a soul-shaking experience, and I have been following ever since.

This is the background for my more recent experience with the Holy Spirit. I had sensed for some time that most of us Christians were not accomplishing what we should be accomplishing in these times. We seemed unable to witness effectively very often, and our

prayers lacked the power of the New Testament church. Last fall, after hearing the Rev. Dennis Bennett speak before a breakfast group sponsored by the Spokane, Washington, chapter of the Full Gospel Men's Fellowship International about the Baptism of the Holy Spirit in his own life and those of many of his parishioners, I began to realize why this was so. We could not perform as Christians with power because we did not have the power.

Many were the hours I spent thinking and praying about this. Due to a natural reticence on my part, I hoped I could receive the Baptism of the Spirit in my own prayer closet, without help from anyone else; but however close it might have been, it never came. I decided this reticence was the obstacle that needed to be removed. Therefore, one day, I called Byron Klaue, a business man who, with his wife, Eleanor, has helped many who were hungering for a closer relationship with God. In the seclusion of his office they prayed for me, and I received! It was a wonderful experience—not so much emotional as it was powerful. I knew without a trace of doubt, as this strange tongue came to my lips, that here was indeed the Holy Spirit, as real, as tangible, as filled with creativity and power, as He was centuries ago on the day of Pentecost when He first visited

the church! I also knew, and know, that He expects no less of us now than He did of the apostles then.

I have talked to many people since that day about this experience, and they all have questions. The main one, almost always asked, is, "What do you think is the advantage of this?"

I know that these people are too often thinking of the gift of tongues as something separate from the rest, so I first try to explain that it is only a part of the whole. After that, I would say that some of the advantages are these:

First, I know of myself that I am at one with God's Holy Spirit. The tongues assure me of that, because I know it could not have come from anyone or anything else. It is a tremendous thought to realize that God in His Spirit is speaking through one's own mouth.

Second, I know that I am a better wife and mother. Without having to remember Christian ethics or consciously try, I can make our home a more serene and happy place in which to live. Love is real!

Third, I know that I am a better witness. Because the Holy Spirit can speak through me, instead of my speaking through my own efforts, even though my own efforts have been dedi-

cated to God's will.

Fourth and last, and perhaps most important of all, I know that I can pray more effectively. This was one of the things that I had particularly sensed a need of before — a power in prayer that I knew was lacking in my life most of the time. Now, in two ways, this is changed. First, private prayer in tongues bridges a gap, or, one might say, breaks through the "word barrier" which many have found in deep prayer. When the depth and intensity of prayer goes beyond words, it cannot be maintained for long, except by prayer in tongues, which is the prayer of the Holy Spirit making "intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

The other way in which my prayer life is changed is that I feel very close to God as I pray. I know the reality and personality of God in Christ and what He did for all of us. Therefore I am confident that my petitions and praises are reaching Him. This confidence is real. I don't have to coax myself into it; it is just there because God is real.

There is much more that could be said, of course. This is too vast a thing to compress into a few paragraphs. However, I do rejoice that this new life has come to me, and that it has come to so many in the so-called orthodox denominations. Now is the time when we most need to look to the hour of Christ's coming again, for He is preparing His Church. There are many Presbyterians, Episcopalians, Methodists and Lutherans who have felt a great need for something deeper and more real, and they are feeling it now. They just don't know what it is or where to find it. We must tell them! Thank God we can!

CHRISTIANS SHOULD PREPARE FOR PERILOUS TIMES AHEAD

Salvation By The Blood Of Jesus Christ, Healing By His Stripes, The Baptism Of The Holy Spirit, And The Lord's Return To Earth, Are Major Aspects Of The Faith For Which We Are To Contend, Even

"THE FAITH ONCE DELIVERED TO THE SAINTS!"

AT THE CLOSE of the parable of the widow and the unjust judge, who finally avenged her of her adversary, the Lord said God would also avenge His own elect, and that speedily. Even though He will avenge them, the outstanding question was, "Shall He find faith when He comes back to earth?" This is not personal faith that Jesus is the Christ, but faith in all of the New Testament, to which the Old Testament points in types, shadows and figures.

The lack of faith, which is unbelief, is the outstanding sin. All other sins are attributes or accessories. Unbelief could well be called the Mother Sin, with all other sins as offsprings.

Paul declared that he was obedient unto the faith, and commanded: "Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit ye like men, be strong." He said: "Examine and prove yourself, whether ye be in the faith," "Continue in the faith, grounded, settled and not moved away from it," and asked that we be "rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding therein, with thanksgiving." Titus was told: "Rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith."

Jude, after writing of the common salvation, said it was needful that he write again and exhort them to "earnestly contend for the faith that was once delivered to the saints."

In the light of God's Word, we are warned against being contentious; but not so regarding the Word or the whole body of revealed truth, but instead we are to contend for those things which constitute the faith. God told Joshua to get up from his praying and search out the sin that was in the camp.

With An Operation Coming In An Attempt To Bring Relief,
I Was Prayed For At The Los Angeles Chapter Meeting, And**

I ACCEPTED MY HEALING BY FAITH!

I HAVE HAD a terrible heart condition: irregularity of my heart artery. An operation was scheduled for this coming Friday. This heart irregularity was so bad I haven't been able to work since 1956. I have been living in a hotel in Los Angeles, California, for some time.

A Jewish lady invited me to attend the FGBMFI Los Angeles Chapter breakfast meeting. I had never been in a Pentecostal meeting before or to a Full Gospel Church or any church where they stressed healing, but I decided I would go to hear the broadcast.

This Saturday morning, April 8, 1961, I went up and heard the message that Brother Bowers gave and was very touched. Several times during the meeting, various people would stand and ask for prayer and they would pray for them. I wanted to stand up, but I was afraid, since I had never been in this type of meeting before.

After the meeting was over, I went up to Herbert Bonham, since he had read the prayer requests, and said, "I have a heart condition and I am due for an operation Friday. I would appreciate it if you would pray for me." Brother Bonham got one of the men that was standing near by and they laid hands on me and began to pray in the name of Jesus that I would be healed. I went away not feeling any different.

I went to the hotel and started studying some scriptures Brother Bon-

ham had given me about Divine Healing. Then I began to pray. As I prayed, suddenly I realized that the way I had received salvation was through faith, and if I was going to get healing I would have to receive it the same way. I said, "Lord how can I receive healing?" The Lord answered, "You will receive healing by faith;" so right then and there I accepted my healing by faith!

I felt so wonderful that I rushed out of the hotel room, walked three blocks away, and started passing out tracts. When I came back to my room, instead of taking the elevator, I felt so good I walked up four flights of stairs. IN AN INTERESTING BOOK, *The Magic power of Your Mind*, Dr. Walter Germain tells of a man of 80 who was hit by a truck while crossing the street and killed. Autopsy revealed many tuberculosis scars on the man's lungs, and extensive evidence of ulcers. The heart and kidneys showed considerable deterioration. The medical examiner telephoned the widow. "How old did you say your husband was?" he asked.

"He was eighty," the widow answered.

"With all the things that were wrong with him," the doctor told her, "he lived 30 years beyond his time. How do you account for his vitality and energy in the face of such medical history?"

"Well," she replied, "I wouldn't know except that my husband never went to bed at night without saying, 'I will be better tomorrow.'"

This is a clear illustration of the fact that even when there are physiological difficulties in the human body, the focusing upon them of the health-producing, dynamic, creative power of the mind helps. The more I try to study the ways of God and man, the more convinced I am that God has given us more power over our own lives than any of us has ever taken. For He has given us the power to think, the power to believe, the power to have faith — and thus the power to channel into our lives His creative forces.

It's so easy to become discouraged and moan, "Everything's going bad with me. I'm licked." People will think you are a pathetic figure — and you will indeed be just that. Furthermore, thinking that way is likely to affect events and you adversely.

If, on the other hand, you ask God for hope and optimism, He will create in you a new Spirit. And how important to your well-being this is! Remember the words from the Proverbs, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he." With God's help you can do amazing things in your life if you want to do so with all your heart, which means with all of your deep desire and real faith. You are master of your life — God and you!

**Twenty Years Ago, A Young Minister Brought Healing To Her Baby,
And In The Two Decades Since, Hundreds Have Been Healed, As This**

Rector's Wife Practices Laying On Of Hands!

MRS. AGNES SANFORD is the dignified, matronly wife of an Episcopal Rector in Westboro, Massachusetts, and the mother of three grown children. She impresses you as a practical, forthright, completely sincere woman who would not try to delude anyone, including herself.

Mrs. Sanford believes that Jesus meant exactly what He said when He told His disciples they were to heal the sick and that James, the brother of Jesus, meant it when he said to heal the sick by laying hands on them and praying for them.

If you ask why she believes this, she has a simple and unarguable answer:

"I've seen it happen—hundreds of times."

The first time was many years ago, when a young minister came to call on her infant son, who had been ill for six weeks with abscessed ears.

"I'll go up and have a prayer with your child," he told Mrs. Sanford.

"I don't think it will do any good," she replied wearily. "He's only a baby and he wouldn't understand."

"That won't matter," the young minister said.

Without further argument, he went upstairs, placed his hands gently on the baby's head, and prayed briefly. Mrs. Sanford remembers vividly what happened next.

"The fever flush died out of my

baby's face immediately. He turned very pale, closed his eyes and slept. When he woke, he was well."

During the past 20 years, Mrs. Sanford has laid her own compassionate hands on a great number of people who were suffering from a wide variety of mental and physical illnesses. She has carried on this healing ministry quietly, without flamboyant personal publicity, and within the institutional framework of the Episcopal Church.

She has not tried to keep a scorecard of recoveries, but there have been enough of them, she feels, to justify and even heighten her conviction that God's healing power flows into sick bodies and minds today, no less dramatically than in the time of Christ.

Mrs. Sanford does not like to speak of healing "miracles." She believes strongly that "God has made a world that runs by law, and He does not like to break those laws." Christian healing, she feels, is simply an application of His spiritual laws, fully as "natural" as medical science, which is an application of God's physical laws to healing.

Many Christians believe that spiritual healing is possible, but that actual occurrences are comparatively rare. When prayer does not lead to recovery of a sick person, they assume that it was not God's will that healing should occur in that case.

Mrs. Sanford thinks this is a timid

TWO GREAT EVENTS IN TOKYO AND TWO DIFFERENT RESULTS

Two significant events occurred in the world's largest city in October, in two famous halls in Tokyo. In Hibiya Hall, Japan's top politicians were gathered, including Prime Minister Hayato Ikeda and Socialist party Chairman Asanuma, debating political issues.

Asanuma spoke first. He was largely responsible for organizing the snake dance Red demonstrators that led to the cancellation of Eisenhower's visit to Japan last June.

As Asanuma was speaking, 17-year-old Yamaguchi jumped to the platform and stabbed a sword twice into the speaker's body. Spectators in the hall and on TV watched this assassination with horror.

At the larger nearby Kyoritsu Hall, a spectacle of a different sort took place. Nightly Dr. Oswald J. Smith, Founder and Missionary Pastor of the Peoples Church of Toronto, Canada, spoke to the crowds that gathered. His was a message of life and salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. At his invitation to accept Christ, hundreds flocked forward nightly.

The inquiry room was a hallowed

scene. Tears flowed down the cheeks of the penitent. Earnest prayers were heard. Among those who came forward was a 67-year-old university professor.

The seekers were dealt with individually by 400 counsellors, trained for two months by the Navigators. The students were dealt with in a separate place and it was a heart-warming sight. Many were the same age and dressed in a student uniform as Assassin Yamaguchi. What a pity that this young man's tragic life could not have been changed by a similar contact with the Gospel!

**God Is Moving By His Spirit Deep In The Arctic Circle,
And Love And Unity Exist Among Eskimos And Outsiders, As**

A Revival Transforms Entire Town In Alaska

DEEP IN THE ARCTIC CIRCLE, the snow-bound town of Wainwright, Alaska, a community of Eskimos, trappers and fishermen, has been experiencing a spiritual awakening of staggering proportions since last fall, Christian Life Magazine reports.

Up until then, most of the town's 250 inhabitants were associated with its two churches — Presbyterian and Assemblies of God — in name only. Few had ever experienced a definite conversion.

Today virtually all of Wainwright has turned to Jesus Christ.

In November, the spiritual awakening for which a few saints had prayed for two years began. First signs of revival became evident when the Rev. E. R. Danks, a Presbyterian missionary, conducted a week of meetings. Many older Eskimos responded to the invitation to accept Christ as Savior and Lord.

Following Danks by two weeks, the Rev. and Mrs. O. Butterfield arrived at the Assemblies of God church for two weeks of meetings. This time young people began to surrender to Christ.


Results were spontaneous. People righted wrongs, renewed friendships that had been severed for years. In one meeting in the Presbyterian church, all but two of the 75 present came forward for dedication to Christ.

Miles away, out on the tundra, a young man with his sled and dog team suddenly became so aware of the presence of the Lord that he returned to the village a changed man.

Many have stopped using tobacco. Several have enrolled in Bible study courses despite language handicaps. Formerly the village had two commercial movie projectors. Today, so many people attend church instead that only one remains and it is in operation only three nights a week.

Clearly, a new spirit of unity and love exists throughout the village of Wainwright. Frequently regular church services become times of testimony and praise continuing three hours at a time.



Miss Ritasarani Rajanayagam, who has chosen this path, declares: "Acceptance has to be all or nothing. To accept Christ is to break caste, to deny one's cultural heritage. It means to be dead to one's family, with disinheritance and funeral rites marking the finality of this death. Thus for the Asian, Christianity necessarily calls men and women to crucifixion with Christ, no less in the family than in the nation."

Miss Rajanayagam came to the United States from Asia as a Buddhist. During the course of her studies she began to read the Bible, and as a result accepted Jesus Christ as her Saviour. When she sent word of her decision back to her family, they conducted a funeral pyre and burned her body in absentia. She is now legally dead in her home country and can not go back as the same person again. She has been disinherited, disowned and declared dead. All financial assistance and support has been cut off, so she is now left stranded in the United States.

"Though dead," Ritasarani says, "the Asian Christian must continue to live among abuses with no right and no privileges." But she counted the cost before making her decision and is going on with the Lord.

"As a Buddhist I was taught to seek truth. I sought and I found the Truth. Jesus Christ is the way, the truth and the life."

Miss Rajanayagam believes that the

situation is ripe in Buddhist countries for a great turning to Christ if it can be led by nationals who are Buddhist converts.



## **RELIGION CAN BE VERY DANGEROUS!**

**T**HE LAW REQUIRES poison bottles to be clearly labeled as such in order to prevent accidental deaths. Unfortunately, no such law exists to protect the unsuspecting in the matter of religion. There are countless deadly religions and millions perish spiritually because of them. No wonder so many are lost! With each religion claiming to be the true one, how are people to know the real way to God amidst such a bewildering situation?

There is a way to know, and perhaps you'll be surprised to learn that there is a test which will identify the true way to God. The religions of the world ask men to believe something, whereas the Bible asks men to receive Someone: "... as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God" (John 1: 12).

Receiving a Person is not the same thing as accepting religious doctrines. This then is the test—receiving Christ! One can believe all the things that he wants to, but that's not the same as receiving a Person.

Perhaps you are one who is religious. Does your religion include a personal encounter with Jesus Christ? If not, you are in danger. Why, even Christianity is dangerous as a religion if all one has is Bible doctrine and not Christ personally.

The Word of God testifies that the Christ of the Bible is a risen, living Person. He who said, "I am the Life,"

lives; and right this minute knocks at the door of men's hearts. Hear His offer of Himself: "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in . . ." (Revelation 3:20).

That door, dear friend, is the door of your heart. Either the Bible lies or Christ is waiting to come into your heart this moment. There's only one way to find out, only one true test. Religious claims cannot be taken into a chemistry or physics laboratory for testing and certification: they have to be taken into the laboratory of personal experience. They are lived, not merely analyzed.

How often you have said, "Come in," to your neighbor's knock at the front door. Won't you respond to Jesus' knock at your heart's door? He awaits your invitation. Just bow your head where you are and say to Him: "Dear Lord, I open the door of my heart right now. I ask You to come in. I want to know You as my personal Saviour. Amen."

Can you do that? If you will, then God will do the rest. With this one simple act you will be saved from the death of religious poisoning. Why perish when God loves you so and has provided this way of genuine salvation? Millions have found the sweetness of God's forgiveness through this prayer of the open heart. Do it now, dear friend; it is the greatest opportunity of your life!


