I had fallen asleep, forgetting to breathe. I was dying. Then I remembered what my mom had told me. I said, "God, if you will help me, then I will try to get my life in order." Then a friend from Chile came with a bottle of whiskey. He stayed there all night. He would give me little sips of whiskey to keep me awake until the morning came. When I finally came to, and the drug had subsided, I was taken to the hospital there in Angola.

A hashish pipe caused me to experience an appendicitis attack. I was in the hospital about 30 days where a Russian doctor operated on me. That experience frightened me. I was outside of my country for a whole year at the young age of only 19. After that, I returned to Chile. When I got home, my dad told me, "Son, it is so good that you are coming back to study." I didn't even have in my mind one thought of

coming back to study. But so as not to upset my father, I said, "Okay, I'll study." I was in the university for five years. Even though I knew the difference between right and wrong, I kept smoking, drinking, partying, etc. But I felt it was not as I should be living. I did not feel good about what I was doing.

My mom spoke a lot with me about believing in the Lord and seeking the Lord. I did not listen with my heart, but I listened out of respect for her. My other brothers did not listen at all. My mom always planted seeds in my heart. She always gave me a little New Testament. Out of my love for her, I would take it and put it into my bag; and forget about it. But when I was traveling after high school graduation, that drug experience had quite a strong effect on me.

During the second year at the university, I met my wife. I fell in

love the moment I saw her. But she was a whole lot different than I was. She was studious, relaxed, laid back, and very beautiful. I thought to myself, "She would never like someone like me, because of my lifestyle." Since her brother was studying the same course that I was, I began to

I was invited to another Chapter meeting. In that meeting they


